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INTRODUCTORY WORD OF THE FOUNDER

The life of a single parent is very specific because they have to deal in one person the duties of two people, which entails many constraints, whether in terms of time or finances. However, a common feature of single parents is the main task, and which is to provide the best possible care for the children so that they are happy and content. However this is challenging under standard conditions, the last three years have been extremely challenging for single parent families in the Czech Republic. The two-year period marked by the coronavirus crisis has put many families not only in financial but into an existential crisis, and in the aftermath we all collectively hoped that we would return to a period of so-called normality. Unfortunately, 2022 proved to be challenging again, not because of Covid, but because of the economic impact high inflation, which caused a substantial increase in the basic cost of living especially in housing and food.



Our nonprofit organization always strives to respond quickly to the changing conditions and situations, so last year all of our assistance programs were promptly adapted to the real needs of solo parents.

If they are forced from day to day to adapt to new, non-standard and changing situation, we stand by their side and do the same. It is a great honour and motivation to continue our work, the fact that in the past year we have secured financial and material assistance worth CZK 13.6 million last year, the largest part of which was financial assistance within the framework of our assistance programme. We contribute up to CZK 5,000 for food or up to CZK 15,000 for housing costs for the families in need. Our seasonal assistance programmes have not been left out either, such as summer camps and outdoor schools, financial contributions for school supplies under the Back to School program, or the traditional Christmas tree of wishes, where we grant specific wishes to children from incomplete families in need.

Another success of the past year was the establishment of the Clothing Bank based by Prague ZOO, which has become an equal partner of the Food bank network of individual regions in the country. The idea behind the establishment was very simple, it was to create a new link and connect the activities of existing entities, thus synergy and increase the effect of jointly provided material aid.

We are very pleased that the Clothing Bank as a project with social assistance lines and ecology has met with a very positive response, as evidenced by the regular employee clothing collections from major companies, daily donations from the general public and, on the other hand, the growing list of direct applicants for or lists of needs from cooperating food partners food banks or local non-profit organisations.

We will continue to monitor the situation in 2023 and will continue to try to help families to be as close as possible to single parents across the Czech Republic and help them in every difficult situation. However, this would never be possible despite our utmost determination and efforts, if it were not for you, the donors, who stand by our side and support our families who do not have their own capacity and strength to to extricate themselves from an adverse life situation. And for that we thank you very much and appreciate your kind help.

ABOUT US

Klub svobodných matek / Single mothers club – full support for single parents

The non-profit organization Single Mothers Club z.s. has been operating for six years and is the only non-profit organization that focuses on comprehensive support for single parents from Czech Republic, built on several pillars of assistance, namely financial, material, legal, information and expertise.

Financial assistance is provided over the long term under the main assistance programme (up to 5,000 for food or up to 15,000 for housing) and seasonal assistance programmes (payment of summer camps, contribution to school supplies, provision of Christmas gifts, etc.). Material assistance is mainly provided in the form of clothing, where the main centre of action is in the Clothing Bank, through which the distribution of clothing in 2022 almost 22 tonnes of clothing to more than 5,000 people in need across the Czech Republic (single parents, seniors, homeless people, refugees, families and single people in difficult life situation). We receive clothing from private donors from all over the Czech Republic, who send clothes to the Clothing Bank using a code for free shipment by the Postal Service and also from companies that organise employee collections as part of their CSR policy.

In addition to the direct distribution of aid at the headquarters of the Clothing Bank, the main distribution partner is the Federation of Food Banks, through which the largest amount of help goes to the Food Bank Džbánsko, PB for Prague and the Central Bohemian Region, PB for the Ústí nad Labem Region, PB for the Karlovy Vary Region, PB for the South Bohemian Region, PB for the Region, PB in the Olomouc Region, PB Central, PB Vysočina and PB Pardubice. Among others organizations with which we work closely to distribute clothing include the Asylum House Mladá Boleslav, AD Mělník, AD Horáčkova, AD and NDC Příbram, AD St. Terezie, AD Kralupy, AD Šromova, AD Zahradní město, General University Hospital Prague 2, Parish Charity Prague 1, Centre for Social Services Na Zámečku, House of Good, Prague 10 Municipality, Municipal District Prague 1, Prague 14, Mental Health Centre, Romodrom, Social Centre Slunce, Naděje, Člověk v Tísni. Patronage of the Clothing Bank project was taken over by The Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, the Ministry of the Environment and the Mayor of the Capital City of Prague. The second channel of material aid is our project of charitable Fashion Charity Shops, in which a portion of donated clothing is offered for symbolic prices and all proceeds from the sale are used for the above mentioned programs of our non-profit organization. We currently operate three shops, two in Prague, Czech Republic. Holešovice and the third is a recently opened branch in Hovorčovice. Other lines of assistance of our non-profit organization are, for example, the information portal with guides for single parents' living situations at www.klubsvobodnychmatek.cz, a free legal advice service in the field of family law and social affairs, and free recovery of maintenance arrears or obtaining replacement maintenance. For single parents there is also a free telephone helpline.



KEY ACTIVITIES

JANUARY

We kicked off 2022 with an increase in financial contributions to our flagship programme assistance. The rising cost of housing, energy, food and utilities has become another, imaginary notch in the tight budgets of solo parents, who were often unable to support the additional financial burdens, as evidenced by the increasing number of requests for assistance from families who were coming in. What had originally been an "emergency" Covid program became a mainstream assistance program and single parents could now apply for a grant of up to CZK 15,000 towards the costs of housing costs and up to CZK 5 000 for food purchases. The amount of assistance provided exceeded the CZK 800 000 for the month and was distributed among 9 dozen families of solo parents in need.

In January, material assistance was provided to 40 solo parents and their children. Almost every package aid package this time included a warm winter jacket, which was greatly appreciated by all of the recipients.



Activities of our Fashion Charity Shop in Holešovice, Prague were supported by the popular actress Andrea Růžičková, who donated for a needy mother a luxury stroller with complete accessories, worth several dozen thousand crowns.



KEY ACTIVITIES

FEBRUARY

February 2022 was marked by major events. A second branch of our Fashion Charity Shop was opened in Ostrava. The beautiful premises were provided free of charge by Forum Nová Karolina shopping centre, which the Single Mothers and Single Parents Club has been supporting for a long time.



Due to the escalation of the war in Ukraine, our organization has become involved in nationwide support, specifically with a collection of medicines and medical supplies, in which we cooperated with other non-profit organizations and competent institutions.

Another new development outside the financial and material aid area was the launch of a new programme of support for single parents in the area of their employment in the labour market. According to STEM public opinion results for our organisation in the previous year the majority of single parents were employed.

A fifth were stay-at-home (on maternity, parental, caring or disability pensioners) and more than a tenth were unemployed. The survey reveals the long-term dismal situation of single parents in the labour market. We established a project called Job Academy for single parents. At the outset, each candidate was interviewed a detailed assessment of their current situation was carried out, defining their strengths and weaknesses. Part of the programme included the production of a high quality professional CV and preparation for the job interview, personal presentation of the candidate at social networks and job portals. We also remembered to provide suitable retraining and language courses and assistance in finding specific job including material support in the form of job aids. General JTI was the general partner of the Job Academy project.

In February we also managed to distribute 808,000 crowns in aid to 81 solo parent families and their children. Other families in need then received half a tonne of clothing.



KEY ACTIVITIES

MARCH

In March, the largest donor in terms of material aid was clearly the company Lidl, which organised a large employee clothing collection. The clothes were donated to the single parent families, nearly 600 kilograms of women's and children's clothing were collected. The material aid distributed by us exceeded one tonne of clothes and was distributed among two hundred families of solo parents in need. In terms of financial aid, we closed the first quarter with a balance of CZK 2.5 million, which helped nearly three hundred single-parent families, primarily with the cost of housing and food security.

VIP visits to our Fashion Charity shop were also held this month- This time in the form of a visit from popular actress Eva Decastelo, who together with representatives of the Donart film production, presented women's and children's clothing in the form of film costumes from the filming of the movie "Forgiven", which was subsequently released in cinemas.



KEY ACTIVITIES

APRIL

Most of the requests the Single Mothers Club received in April were for help with housing assistance. Another large amount of requests were for food assistance, with the holidays approaching, the number of requests for help with summer camp and its fees for children was also growing. In April, we sent financial assistance to 83 families, among whom we distributed almost three quarters of a million crowns. We also delivered 680 kilograms to 136 recipients of clothing. The rising cost of living has already brought single parent families to their knees, who had been able to meet their regular monthly expenses without help.

We were delighted to receive a material donation from the Stillking production and film company. Filmmakers donated a large amount of clothing. In the course of 2021, near our shop in Holešovice, Prague, were shot some scenes from the film The Gray Man and our non-profit organization was chosen as the symbolic recipient of a large of the costumes that were used in the filming of the movie. Another important donor was Česká spořitelna, who organized a large employee clothing collection for single parent families.



KEY ACTIVITIES

MAY

In May, it was already clear that the holidays were slowly approaching. For the first time since the beginning of the year we've seen more requests for help paying for camp than we had requests for help buying food or rent. Our May survey of applicants showed that one quarter of single parents had just CZK 2,000 left after paying their housing costs to all other expenses (food, groceries, clothes, clubs, school and kindergarten lunches, etc.). In recent months, single parents have had to cut back on food purchases (77%), clothing and footwear (77%) and spending on children's activities and summer camps (42 one-third had to cut back on health care (medicines, braces for children etc.). More than half (55%) of solo parents had to borrow money for basic living expenses costs. In May, our aid went to 173 single-parent families. A further 61 families received help from us received material aid packages. The gradually worsening situation of single parents began to be noticed by the Czech media, which regularly reported on the situation.



The Job Academy was in full swing and the participants of the first run had already started their new jobs. We helped the mothers with the creation of a CV and a motivation letter, the personal interviews and a definition of their needs, we selected suitable job positions that met the job requirements in terms of workload, hours and financial compensation. Each adept who participated in the Job Academy project received one year of access to the Seduo online training portal and a number of other benefits. Project partner JTI was the partner of the Job Academy.



KEY ACTIVITIES

JUNE

In June, we again secured contributions for summer camps, with dozens more children leaving thanks to our support or the support of our donors to their dream summer camp. There was a great deal of interest also for the suburban camps in Prague. Total aid for the first six months of 2022 exceeded CZK 5 million and was distributed to almost six hundred single parent families in need. The largest part of this was related to assistance with the costs of housing, which was understandable, as rent and utilities made up the largest item on tight family budgets.

In June we had the opportunity to participate in the presentation of a cultural and charity project, where in the creative writing courses of René Nekuda a book of 14 authors with entitled Hourly. The book launch took place in June and all the proceeds from the the authors donated all the proceeds of the book to our organization to help single parent families.



Another celebrity who has been working with our organization for a long time is Jitka Boho, who gave an interview not only about her private life, but also about our cooperation on a web www.prozeny.cz.

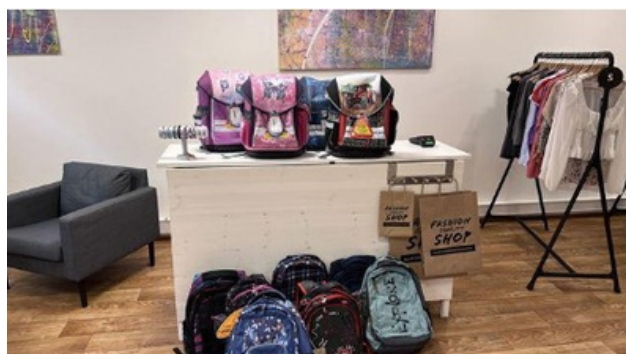

KEY ACTIVITIES

JULY

WIKY company donated beautiful goods for schoolchildren and so in July, apart from regular packages of clothes, we also shipped new school bags and school backpacks. This month we started our regular Back to School program. Single parents have begun to submit applications for school supplies and IT equipment, clubs, school lunches and nursery and also for contributions to outdoor schools. The amount we spent on helping solo parents in July was CZK 844,700. This was distributed among 95 families and helped with housing, food, camps and school supplies. In the hot summer days, we also worked in the material aid warehouse, so 565 kilograms of food went to 113 families clothing and school backpacks.



We had an amazing day at the RoSa Center event at the end of the month. We loaned out interesting models from our Fashion Charity Shop for the 8th annual Fashion Senior Gala Show.



KEY ACTIVITIES

AUGUST

Eurowag organized a large clothing collection for us. With prices rising of most basic necessities of life, material assistance in the form of clothing was very welcome relief to the budgets of single parent families.



In August, we distributed CZK 948,168 among solo parents and their children. While the children of incomplete families enjoyed holidays at camps to which we contributed, we sent financial aid to needy families during the two holiday months in an incredible amount of almost 1.8 million crowns. In August, after months of working together and preparation, a four-part report with the mothers' stories was published on www.seznam.cz of single mothers on how they are managing in a tight economic climate and whether they are at real risk of falling into poverty.

Drtí mladé, staré, z měst i vesnic.“ říká zakladatelka Dana Pavlousková. „Nově dostáváme žádosti o pomoc od samoživitelů, kteří situaci dosud zvládali. Tvoří zhruba třetinu,“ dodává.

Některé žadatelky Seznam Zprávám své příběhy otevřeně popsaly, a vznikla tak čtyřdílná série věnovaná matkám žitelkám, které se z různých důvodů ocitly v mimořádně tíživé finanční situaci.

KEY ACTIVITIES

SEPTEMBER

We were well prepared for the start of the new school year and single parent families with with us. We continued to contribute to the Back to School program for school supplies, to pay for lunches, clubs and the purchase of IT equipment. During the month we also published the results of a STEM survey on sustainability in the fashion. Half of the Czech population reported buying second-hand clothing citizens, and the most common motivation was clearly a favourable price. Other motivations were already less important: the possibility of obtaining clothes unavailable in the regular offer, a better feeling about the purchase, consideration for the environment. The prevailing belief among young people was that it is such a environmentally friendly.

This month was the official launch of the Clothing Bank, an extremely large-scale project that provides material assistance in the form of clothing for people in need throughout the Czech Republic in cooperation with regional Food banks and non-profit organisations. The main reason for launching the new project was to help other target groups in addition to single parents. Already a trial run during August showed that there was a great interest in donated clothing. The initiative to set up a clothing bank in cooperation with the network of food banks was also welcomed by the Mayor of Prague, Zdeněk Hřib, and the patronage of the The Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs and the Ministry of the Environment provided the auspices, at the same time all the partners of our organisation joined the project. Part of the project was also the establishment of long-term cooperation with POTEX, a company dedicated to the collection, redistribution and subsequent processing of used textiles.



In the first month of the new school year, we supported 114 single parent families with a total of CZK 960 905. The largest number of requests for assistance was clearly for the cost of housing costs (rent, utilities) and, of course, in the Back to School programme. Towards the end of September, the total volume of clothing issued from our Clothing Bank reached almost 2.5 tons clothing.



KEY ACTIVITIES

OCTOBER

In October, large corporate employee material collections were already in full swing, with supplying the Clothing Bank and our charity shop with nice, reusable clothing. In just 6 weeks of operation, our Clothing Bank managed to distribute an incredible 10 tonnes of clothing to those in need. The largest part of the aid (9 tons) was distributed within the cooperation with selected regional Food banks and local non-profits organizations, while one ton of clothing was distributed directly to interested individuals at the Clothing Bank's headquarters by Prague Zoo.



Exactly CZK 850,845 was the amount of aid we provided in October to a total of 110 single-parent families in need in October. Most of the requests for assistance were again related to the cost of housing and food, but we also started to receive requests for assistance to provide Christmas presents. A special thank you to actress Beata Kaňoková, who after her victory in a special charity episode of the competition show On the Hunt, she chose as the recipient of her prize donation our non-profit organization.



KEY ACTIVITIES

NOVEMBER

As part of the 'Single Parents and Christmas 2022' survey, we monitored how are holding up solo parent families ahead of the upcoming holidays. The survey results were not surprising, the situation for single parents have long been critical. Only one-fifth of single parents had saved money for Christmas presents for their children, nine out of ten parents were unable to meet their children's Christmas wishes or only partially. The highest increase in the cost of living single parents have experienced in food (86%), energy (61%), rent (43%), expenses for children at nursery or school (54%) and clothing (39%):

"I absolutely don't know how I'm going to deal with the increase in electricity from the new year onwards. I don't know where I will get the extra 6-7 thousand just for electricity, let alone for food." Uncertainty Věrka, a single mother, shared her uncertainty in the survey the fact that we don't know when the situation will start to improve. The outlook for next year is depressing. I know I have a job that I enjoy, but as a single mother I find that the I can't save anything from my income at the moment, and I'm worried about sudden expenses that may that may arise. That would put me in a very difficult financial situation. And I can't afford any social security benefits. I'm not entitled to at the moment, having tried to check my welfare entitlement calculations I'm just over the eligibility threshold."

In November, thanks to our partners and sponsors, we were able to help 147 solo families parents with a record amount of CZK 1 177 464. The first government institutions to support the Clothing Bank, with material assistance in the form of clothing provided were the Office of the Government of the Czech Republic, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs of the Czech Republic, whose collections exceeded a magnificent amount of 1.5 tonnes of clothing for families in need.



KEY ACTIVITIES

DECEMBER

December was the most challenging time of the year, mainly due to the finishing of our traditional Christmas programme, through which we provide Christmas presents for as many children, either by sending a specific gift, making a financial contribution or linking donors and families in need. Thanks to individual and corporate donors, we were able to provide Christmas gifts for 744 children from all over the country. This was the largest amount of Christmas gifts ever, we've been able to give to single parents in the history of our organization. Nestlé employees decided to support the children of single parents by purchasing Christmas gifts through the Wish Granting Tree, which was available online at portal of our Fashion Charity Shop. List of specific wishes of children from single-parent families have been fulfilled since the end of October, and to our great delight, all the wishes by Christmas Eve.



Our long term partner helped us to provide a Merry Christmas, this time to the parents. Groupe SEB, which has been supporting single parents for several years and always gives us a big surprise before Christmas. This time it was a fantastic in the form of new electrical appliances from the best brands that have made the a lot of solo parent families.

ECONOMIC REPORT

The financial year 2022 ended with a positive economic result of CZK 5.69 million, revenues amounted to CZK 24.68 million and expenses to CZK 18.99 million.

The organisation's activities are divided into two cost centres, namely the non-profit and the profit part. Revenue in the non-profit part amounted to CZK 23.22 million and expenditure to CZK 17.71 million, with an economic result of CZK 5,51 million. On the expenditure side, the largest expenditure was financial, material and professional assistance to single parent families and related costs (packaging material, transport costs) amounting to CZK 13,64 million. A special item of expenditure was the cost of operating the Clothing Bank, amounting to CZK 0.825 million, which was fully sponsored by a corporate donor. The remaining 18% of the expenses were operating expenses of the organisation (rent for administrative and warehouse premises, energy consumption, insurance, telecommunication services, staff remuneration, accounting and tax services, marketing costs, etc.)

The profit part, consisting of income from ancillary economic activities (income from charitable and e-commerce), income amounted to CZK 1,467 million and expenditure amounted to CZK 1,280 million with CZK 186 621. The main item of expenditure was the deposit in the financial assistance programmes for single parents, rent and energy consumption, consumables and production materials, insurance, staff remuneration and marketing services.
